

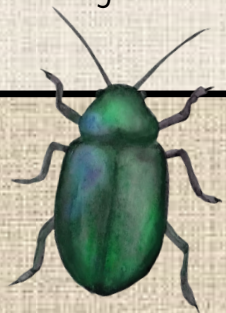
## **This week we have:**

- In Maths, Year 1 have been learning to count on from a number. Year 2 have been learning how to write numbers as words not just numerals, all the way to 100.
- Year 2—English— We have begun our first focus book which is 'Leaf'. We have looked at what a sentence is, what a noun phrase is and we have also created our own noun phrases.
- We have continued our discovery around the question "Is the world changing?" and this week we have specifically looked at all the continents and where they are on a world map. I wonder if your child could name you a continent?
- Last week in DT, we have learnt about the eatwell plate and that we should eat a varied diet to be healthy and this week we have looked at a variety of different fruit and veg to create our own success criteria for a tasty fruit kebab.
- In Computing we have learnt that not everyone is who they say they are online and have found strategies for what to do if we find ourselves in this position.
