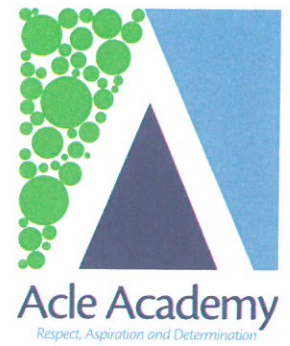

Medication/Medicines in School

Dear Parents/Carers

I would like to take this opportunity to remind you that students should not be carrying medication of any kind on their person at school. Any medication, which has been prescribed or purchased, should be handed in to the school office first thing in the morning and can be collected at the end of the day.

All medication requires a letter from parents or carers, giving parental consent for the medication to be administered, dosage, duration and reason. If the medication is prescription we will require the packaging which indicates dosage.

Inhalers and epinephrine auto-injectors (EpiPens) are exempt from this requirement and students can continue to carry them in case of emergency.

The school reserves the right to seize any medication that a child may be carrying. If your child is taking regular medication outside of school hours, please inform the school office or Engage.
