MESSAGE FROM..... MISS MASON, ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL



I wanted to share how successful students have been in their home learning since the start of term.

To date, students across the school have been awarded **23,732** home learning achievement marks! This is fantastic! We wanted to say a huge well done to the students for all of their hard work and persistence in completing these tasks. We also want to acknowledge the support from parents and carers. Home learning is vitally important in reinforcing concepts taught in the classroom and we want to thank you for your continued support and dedication to your child's success.

At Key stage 3, English, Maths, Science and French/Spanish are set weekly. All other subjects are set once a fortnight or as a project over a longer period of time. We limit tasks to 40 minutes as we know students have extracurricular activities and other important family commitments. At Key stage 4 students should expect one hour of home learning or revision per subject per week.

Home learning will be set via the ClassCharts App. **All tasks will be set on Mondays by 9am** with clear timescales and dates for completion/submission. This enables students and parents and carers to plan the tasks for each day of the week. To further assist, we run a Home Learning Club in the Library every Monday to Friday after school, where students can access computers and complete assignments with support if needed, reducing the workload at home.

The tasks on ClassCharts will have links to the student Google Classrooms where they will be able to work on their assignments and submit. Teachers also use the Google Classrooms to upload lesson slides and other useful resources but all home learning will be clearly defined and labelled.

If you have any trouble accessing ClassCharts or have lost the log in code, please contact the school office or your child's form tutor who can provide this for you. Should you have any concerns about home learning taking longer than expected or your child struggles to access the home learning, please do contact the Head of Year or Key Stage so we can follow this up, or you are welcome to contact teachers directly.
