

This week we have:

- In Maths, Year 1 have been using their skills of addition to solve simple problems such as Sam has 6 sweets and Holly has 2 sweets. How many sweets altogether? Year 2 have been using their knowledge of number bonds to 10 to help them add on 10 to the nearest 10 e.g $23 + ? = 30$ where they can use their knowledge of 3 and 7 makes 10 to help with this calculation.
- Year 2—English— We have been learning about poetry and wrote our own polar bear poems using a structure. We thought about our presentation skills when writing up our poems and we enjoyed performing our poems.
- We have continued our discovery around the question “Is the world changing?” We have explored the issue of ‘global warming’ and considered the impact of climate change particularly on the animals that live in the arctic.
