

This week we have:

- In Maths, Year 1 been continuing their work on subtraction. Year 2 have been adding 10 or a multiple of 10 to a number.
- Year 2—English— The children have been writing descriptively using the book 'Boogie Bear' for inspiration. They have also been using coordinating and subordinating conjunctions.
- In Geography we have continued our learning about climate change and have looked at what can be done to prevent global warming. The children have designed posters to raise awareness.
- DT, we have explored how an axle on a vehicle works and have begun to develop prototypes for our own Arctic vehicles.
- In PE we have continued our dance. topic The children have been exploring artistry and musicality—match movements to music.

Things to do at home:

Year 1— Please go back through your child's phase 3 phonics folder and practice recognising the sounds that your child may find it tricky to recall. This is **vital** to ensure that your child continues to make good progress with their reading and writing

Year 2— Practise quick recall of number bonds to 10 and 20. This helps your child to develop good maths fluency which will support them in other areas of maths.

Reminder— Phonics/Spelling Folders **MUST** be in school on **Wednesday** to be added to. Reading books **MUST** be in school on **Thursday** to be changed.
