

Hellesdon High School's Young Carers' Agreement

What we expect from Young Carers?	What Young Carers can expect from us?
To take part as fully as possible in lessons and opportunities offered.	Ensure 'Young Carers' is a topic explored in tutor time/ assemblies and PSHRE lessons, as well as staff training. At KS4: inform our Careers advisor as to known young carers; make young carers a priority to meet with, and look at realistic options for further education. Make referrals to the Employability and Transitions adviser from Carers Matter.
Tell us in advance if there are issues completing homework/classwork due to caring demands.	Explore the possibility of homework extensions. Support students to complete homework during the school day and avoid issuing behaviour marks if extension issued.
Make us aware if your caring role increases.	If needed we will: Allow young carers to contact home from Head of Year's office or Miss Thetford's office if they are worried during the school day.
Let us know if you need more support.	Have a named Young Carer lead who will meet young carers and provide support. Provide information or make referrals to Young Carers' groups, Young Carers' Forum, Young Carer Needs Assessment or any other appropriate services. Invite young carers to the Young Carer Google Classroom, which will allow students to communicate easily with the Young Carer Lead.
