

This week we have:

- In Maths, Year 1 have been looking at place value with numbers up to 20. They have practiced this on a numberline followed by looking at one more and one less. Year 2 have been subtracting two numbers together using the 10s and ones and have been exchanging a 10 for ones e.g for $22 - 15 =$.
- Year 2—English— It was lovely to see so many of you at the English workshop, the children loved creating the start of their stories with their adults. We have continued our work with 'Boogie Bear' and began writing our own stories only changing a few things making it slightly different to the original story.
- In DT we have begun to create our arctic vehicles. The children worked fabulously well together to turn their base of the car (cereal box) inside out which will create a great plain base to allow children to paint their vehicle when the time comes.

Things to do at home:

Year 1— Please go back through your child's phase 3 phonics folder and practice recognising the sounds that your child may find it tricky to recall. This is **vital** to ensure that your child continues to make good progress with their reading and writing

Year 2— Practise quick recall of number bonds to 10 and 20. This helps your child to develop good maths fluency which will support them in other areas of maths.
