Can your child give you oral instructions to tell you how to do a task? Follow them exactly to ensure they are clear and precise (even if it means you do it wrong!)

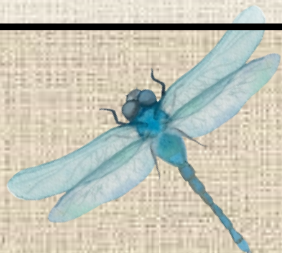
Play Simon Say s using bossy imperative verbs such as “touch”, “wiggle” , “jump”, “turn” etc.
