## School Uniform - Summer Term 2026

As we approach the summer term, we wish to express our sincere gratitude to all our students for their excellent adaptability and cooperation with the introduction of our new uniform this academic year. We have been impressed by their commitment to maintaining high standards of appearance and it has been brilliant to see them wearing their uniform with pride. We also extend our thanks to you, parents and carers, for your crucial support in ensuring students adhere to these standards.

To maintain these high standards and ensure a smooth transition into the summer months, we must reaffirm our uniform expectations for the upcoming summer term.

### Uniform Expectations for the Summer Term:

- **Jumper:** The plain black V-neck jumper with school logo is optional in the summer term.
- **Shirt and Tie:** The white, collared, button-up shirt (long or short sleeved) and the school tie remain compulsory all year. Please ensure shirts are tucked in at all times. If the weather gets really warm, we will relax rules on shirts being tucked in. Expect us to let both students and parents and carers know if this is the case.
- **Trousers/Shorts/Skirts:** Students must wear smart, black trousers (no jeans, jogging bottoms, leggings, or tight/stretchy materials) OR a black pleated skirt with school logo (worn at full length, not rolled up) OR smart, black, tailored shorts (knee length, no cargo or sports shorts).
- **Footwear:** Smart black shoes/leather-look trainers that are all black with no visible logo, along with plain black cotton socks (no visible logo), are compulsory all year.
- **Appearance:** Please remember all other expectations:
  - **Jewellery:** Limited to one stud in each ear lobe and one stud in the nose, one necklace, one bracelet, and one ring. All must be removed for practical subjects.
  - **Hair:** No unnatural colours are permitted.
  - **Nails/Make Up:** No nail extensions or fake nails, and make up should be natural looking.

Your continued support is greatly appreciated as we head into the final term of the academic year. If your child is missing a piece of uniform, the Easter break provides the perfect opportunity to purchase a replacement. For example, items such as the school tie can be purchased from Birds of Dereham. Students in Year 7, 8, 9 and 10 will wear the same colour tie next academic year. If you have any difficulties purchasing uniform items for your child, please contact your child's Head of Year.
