Build a replica model of the Artemis 2 spacecraft. The model can be physical or digital. Once the model has been made either bring it into school or send a photo of it on the class Dojo account, along with a quick description of how you made it.

Slavery Factfile

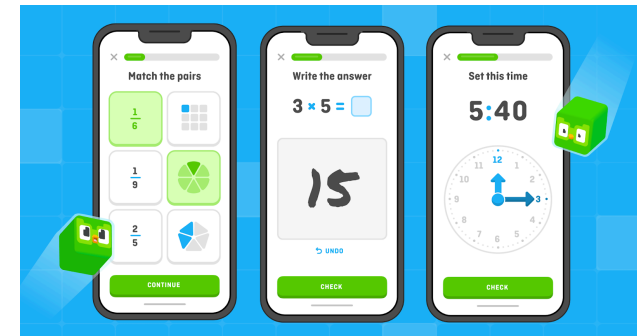
Explore what slavery looked like in England before the Normans landed in 1066. How did the Vikings and Saxons view slavery?
