- In Maths, Year 1 have been exploring weight and using the scales to find out which objects are heavier or lighter. Year 2 have had an introduction to fractions focusing on half. We have been talking about a half is 2 equal parts which together make a whole. We have looked how a half is written as a fraction.
- In English we have continued learning about diaries. We have been writing our own diary entry about our morning from the time we get out of bed to arriving at school. We needed to remember to write in the past tense and using time words such as first, then, next, after that and finally. We have had a go at editing our work using blue pens— checking for capital letters, full stops and that our writing makes sense.
- In RE we have been talking about different beliefs and being respectful to all.
