

Summer 1: Home Learning Takeaway Menu - Turtles

Local Memories, Broadening Horizons

Choose 1 task from the takeaway menu each week and bring it on or share it on Class Dojo on a Monday. These are just suggestions, so feel free to follow your own interests, just remember to share what you have done with us. Please remember to read at home every day.



Write a short diary entry about arriving on the Titanic for the first time. Talk about what it looks like from the outside and how much you are looking forward to arriving in New York. You can write about who you are with and why you are going over the Atlantic ocean.

- 1: Write counting in 10s starting at 7 and finishing at 317.
- 2: Write counting in 5s starting at 12 and finishing at 127
- 3: write counting in 2s from 18 to 64.
- 4: Write the 3x table starting at 0 and finishing at 60.

Write a short piece comparing what you wear, do and see when it is hot, compared to what you wear, do and see when it is cold.

Use extended noun phrases and draw and label pictures to compare the different times - for example the view of your garden or park or a diagram showing what you wear.



Draw a magical secret garden, with lots of beautiful and exciting things to see, touch and smell.

Write three sentences with extended noun phrases that describe parts of the picture.

Help mummy and Daddy do one important job at home. Either take photos, write about it or draw and label a picture telling us what you did and the results. How did it make you feel to help out?

Practise your 2,3,5 and 10x table. When you think you can do it, either record yourself doing it or being tested or tell me and I will test you.

Draw and label a clock face with hands and numbers. Label what each hand is for and, if you can, tell me how to tell the time or any time facts that you know.

Talk to a grown-up about their childhood and write down 5 differences you notice, compared to your life today. The older the person, the better!
