Things to do at home:

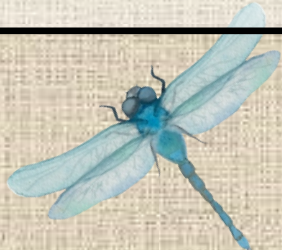
Keep reading your school reading book and practicing words and sounds in spelling/phonics folders.
