

This week we have:

- In Maths, Year 1 have continued their learning about Fractions. They have been finding out how to quarter shapes and how each part has to be equal. Year 2 have also continued their learning about fractions, finding three quarters of a shape and then finding 3 quarters of a number using counters and then pictorially.
- In English we have continued learning about the book 'Tidy'. We have been talking about badgers and what we would like to find out about them. We used different websites and videos to find the information to answer some of our questions.
- For Art, we have been practising our drawing skills and this week we applied everything we have learnt to draw a sunflower. We thought about texture, tone, scale and also which media (pencil, pastel, felt tip) we wanted to use to draw it.
