

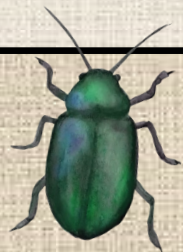
This week we have:

- In Maths, Year 1 have been learning to sort, count and represent objects. Year 2 have been representing numbers on a place value grid, using tens and ones.
